Dr. Vaswani's interest in the health policy arena dates to his time in medical school, where he learned how health policy and advocacy have a major impact on patient care. But it was during his sports medicine fellowship where he decided to take an actionable next step.

"As a Sports Medicine Fellow, I learned about the AANA Health Policy Fellowship and saw it as a great opportunity to advocate for our profession and our patients, educate myself on advocacy and become involved in health policy research," Dr. Vaswani remarks.

During his time as the AANA Health Policy Fellow, Dr. Vaswani has had the opportunity to attend several important conferences and meetings, particularly the annual Coding, Coverage and Reimbursement Committee meetings hosted by the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS). These meetings have served as a catalyst for making important changes and updates to Current Procedural Terminology (CPT)® codes, which help Orthopaedic Surgeons streamline reporting to increase their overall accuracy and efficiency. These experiences helped give Dr. Vaswani a better understanding of the issues that currently face the regulatory environment surrounding arthroscopy and sports medicine.
